1. First slide = Title, picture, and name(s)
Last slide = At least 5 references – MUST use **MLA FORMAT!**



You MUST e-mail me your project the night before your presentation date!

2. Content and Organization:
 - a. Must include slides which clearly **show** and discuss ...

In this order! →

 - ✓ MORPHOLOGY/BODY SYSTEMS
 - ✓ EVOLUTIONARY ADVANCEMENTS
 - ✓ ECOLOGICAL ROLE
 - b. Must incorporate/apply at least one **Essential Knowledge** from each of the 4 Big Ideas!
 - Big Idea 1: The process of evolution drives the diversity and unity of life.
 - Big Idea 2: Biological systems utilize free energy and molecular building blocks to grow, to reproduce and to maintain dynamic homeostasis.
 - Big Idea 3: Living systems store, retrieve, transmit and respond to information essential to processes.
 - Big Idea 4: Biological systems interact, and these systems and their interactions possess complex properties.
 - c. Do not include information that is MUCH too detailed! **See me if you need clarification.**
 - d. MUST use **7x7 Powerpoint format!** See me if you are unfamiliar with this protocol.
 - e. **Each** slide MUST have a picture!
 - f. Be creative: A good Powerpoint captures its audience, without being distracting.
 - g. Key concepts & terms → **larger font** and **bold**
3. You must TEACH the class! Do NOT read from your slides/hand-held notes. A loss of an entire letter-grade will be applied if you do!
4. Your **TEXTBOOK** is your primary resource! The Internet is to be used only for clarification/ elaboration and pictures.
5. **REMEMBER!** You are the “teacher(s)” for your phylum!
